TIPS FOR A SUCCESSFUL VAPA DAY

- If you are auditioning in more than one area, please leave yourself plenty of time between audition times.
- Please be sure of your audition time before signing up.
- If you miss your audition time, please see the director at the end of the auditions.
- If you are auditioning for choir or dance, you must attend the classes/warmups. Do not sign up for any other audition times during these class times.
- Audition rooms may start early and/or run late. Be outside of the audition location 15 minutes before your audition.
- Bring materials needed for the audition as well as water and a snack.
- Read all auditioning requirements (next page)
- Only the directors, and a few student helpers, are allowed in the room. Parents may wait outside of the room while the student auditions.
- Ask questions. If you have any questions about the audition, feel free to reach out to the individual director .
- Have fun. If you are having fun, the others in the room will be having fun. We want to see you succeed. We want to see you at your best.
- Visual arts meetings are not auditions. All freshmen start in fundamentals classes and can work at their own skill level within this class. The meetings are simply to determine what path to pursue, and to meet teachers. Transfer students can be placed in upper level classes based on approval.

CHOIR	Choir Room 402	Students will sign up for 10 minute time slots. They will perform the music learned at the 9:20 Choir Class	Click this link for Choir
DANCE	Studio Room 416	Students will audition in small groups as part of the 9:45 Dance Class. Please wear a leotard and have your hair up.	Click this link for Dance
INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC (Jazz Ens., Orch., Perc., Guit.)	Band Room Room 400	Students should be prepared to play a piece of their choosing that showcases their ability. This can be any style of music. Students may also be asked to play some scales and sight-read a selection of music. Drummers should demonstrate funk, rock, jazz and latin grooves if possible.	Click this link for Instrumental Music
THEATRE (ACTING)	Blackbox Room 502	Students should prepare a 1-2 minute monologue (off book). This monologue should be from a published play. You may also use any of the monologues under the "Audition" tab at irchstheatre.org Students may be asked to do the monologue multiple times	Click this link for Theatre Acting
MUSICAL THEATRE	Blackbox Room 502	Students should prepare a 1-2 minutes of a song (musical theatre songs preferred). A small sound system with an AUX cord will be available. Please have a accompaniment track that is music only (no singing on the track). Student will then be taught a short dance piece (so come dressed to move)	Click this link for Musical Theatre
TECHNICAL THEATRE	Charter Dome	The Technical Director will provide a tour and discussion regarding the different areas of technical theatre available at Charter (lighting, sound, set, costumes, makeup, etc.). Students wishing to attend should follow the link to sign up. You will meet Mr.Darby in The Dome in front of the stage at 9:30am. No specific audition or portfolios are required, but please be ready to discuss any Technical Theatre experience you may have.	Click this link for Technical Theatre
VISUAL ARTS	Art Room Room 500	Feel free to bring samples of your work. The Art teachers will review the different disciplines in the visual arts (drawing, painting, pottery, photography). This meeting is not an audition as all freshmen are placed in fundamentals classes. Each student can work at their skill level within the level 1 class.
